Objectives and Legal Basis of Data Processing:

- Clear identification and registration of external parties (visitors, suppliers, customers, external companies) to ensure traceability of presence in emergency situations (e.g., fire).
- Compliance with legal obligations under § 8 of the Health and Safety at Work Act (AschG) for coordination with external employees (e.g., conducting safety training).
- Maintenance of Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) requirements on the premises of Bosch Rexroth GmbH.
- Investigation of previously committed criminal offenses, accidents, or property damage (clarification and securing of evidence).

Legal Basis: legitimate interests of Bosch Rexroth AG pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR; fulfillment of a legal obligation to which the controller is subject pursuant to Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR; § 8 AschG;

Legitimate interests that we pursue:

Prevention, securing of evidence, and investigation of criminal offenses against a person or the property of Bosch Rexroth GmbH on the factory premises, as well as ensuring that only authorized persons enter the factory premises, and identifying those persons.

Storage period or criteria for determining the period:

The collected data (surname, first name, date of birth, license plate number, company name, company address, time of entry and exit, entrance, completion of safety training) will be stored on a Robert Bosch AG server as part of the registration process for a maximum of 730 days for individuals with external company training and a maximum of 366 days for visitors, unless the data is required beyond this period for specific reasons related to the realization of protection or evidence securing purposes, or for the purpose of transfer to the competent authority or court, or a security authority. After that, the data will be irretrievably overwritten or deleted.

Empfänger oder Kategorien von Empfänger der Daten:

- Employees of Bosch Rexroth GmbH who are involved in plant security/factory security.
- Parties involved in the investigation of incidents where a corresponding legal basis exists (e.g., works council members, injured parties, insurance companies).
- Competent authorities and competent courts in the course of (investigative) proceedings.
- Robert Bosch AG within the framework of providing the servers for data storage
- Bosch Rexroth GmbH uses to collect your data within the framework of access control of ÖWD Österreichischer Wachdienst security GmbH & Co KG, Bayerhamerstr. 14c, A-5020 Salzburg as a processor according to Art. 28 GDPR.

Information on the rights of data subjects pursuant to Art. 15 ff. GDPR

As a data subject, you have the right to obtain confirmation from us about whether or not your personal data relating to you is being processed and if this is the case, you have the **right to access to your personal data**.

You have the right, as far as the legal requirements are fulfilled, to demand the **rectification** of inaccurate personal data concerning you and, if necessary, the **completion** of incomplete personal data from us.

You have the right to request the erasure of your personal data if the legal requirements are fulfilled, e.g. if the data is no longer required for the purposes pursued (**right of erasure**).

If the legal requirements are met, you may request us **to restrict processing**, e.g. if you have contested the processing of your personal data for a period enabling us to check your objection. You have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data for reasons arising from your **particular situation**. We will then no longer process the personal data **unless** we can prove, according to legal requirements, legitimate grounds for the processing, which override your rights.

You have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transmit those data to another controller when the processing is carried out by automated means (**right to data portability**).
